### Special Items to Bring

- ☐ Photos of camper's deceased loved one that can be used in various craft projects.

(For example, a favorite t-shirt that can be cut and sewn into the shape of a heart then stuffed to make a pillow.) The items you provide for making the pillow should be very meaningful to the camper and their relationship with their loved one.

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### Baggage Policy

Each camper should have their own luggage, not bags shared with a sibling. Each camper's luggage should contain only their own clothing, bedding, and toiletries. Please do not pack the belongings for 2 different children in the same bag or expect them to "share" toiletries or other items.

We have a 3-bag limit for each camper (**or** 2 bags plus a sleeping bag). We believe this reduces the number of misplaced items and is especially helpful to younger campers and their house parents.

For returning campers, prior to camp, please remove all Camp Cocoon baggage tags from your child's luggage left over from previous years.
